Tema majoră/ Major theme: Historical Foundations & Intellectual Origins

- 2. From Rome to Lisbon: A Comparative Analysis of Foundational EU Treaties (trace the evolution of EU treaties and their impact on institutional architecture) **OR**
- 3. The Maastricht Treaty and the Birth of the European Union: Political and Economic Implications (explore the shift from economic cooperation to political union)
